Shaded rows are repeated on each side.

Backstitch with one strand:

- Neck and face with 356.
- Eyelashes, eyebrow, and the brooch over fur with 3371.
- Edges of white fur with 680.
- Hands with 3371.
- Curls in hair with 5282.

Backstitch with two strands:

- Top lip and front of lower lip with 315.
- Eyelid with 356.
- Trim on cuffs with 924.

Additional Instructions:

Fill front of lip with 3722.

All beads attached with YLI Wonder Invisible Thread.

If you choose to attach beads with floss, use one strand similar to the color of the bead.

Attach beads with a half cross stitch.

Use one strand when using Kreinik Metallic braids.

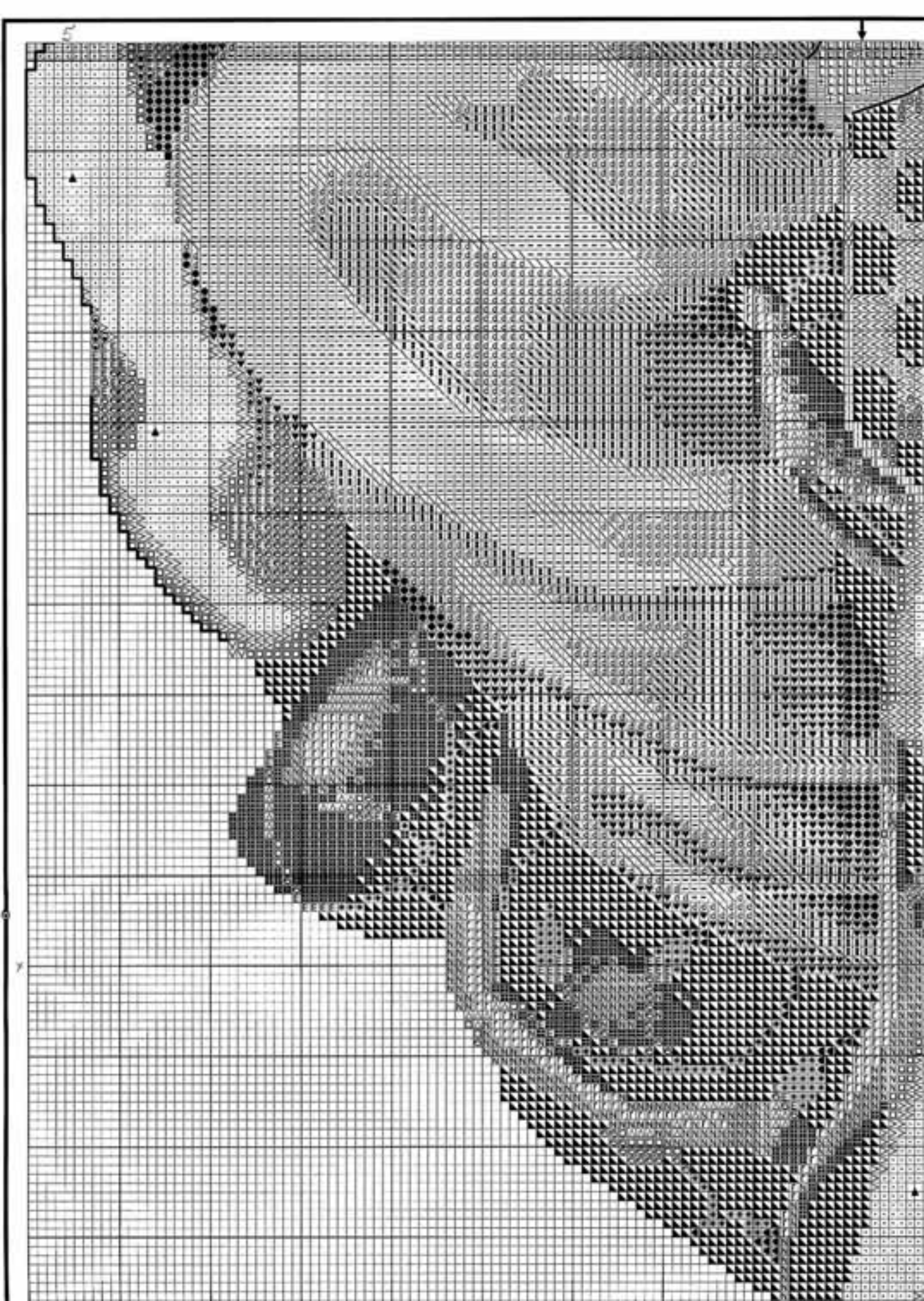
Bead Roping

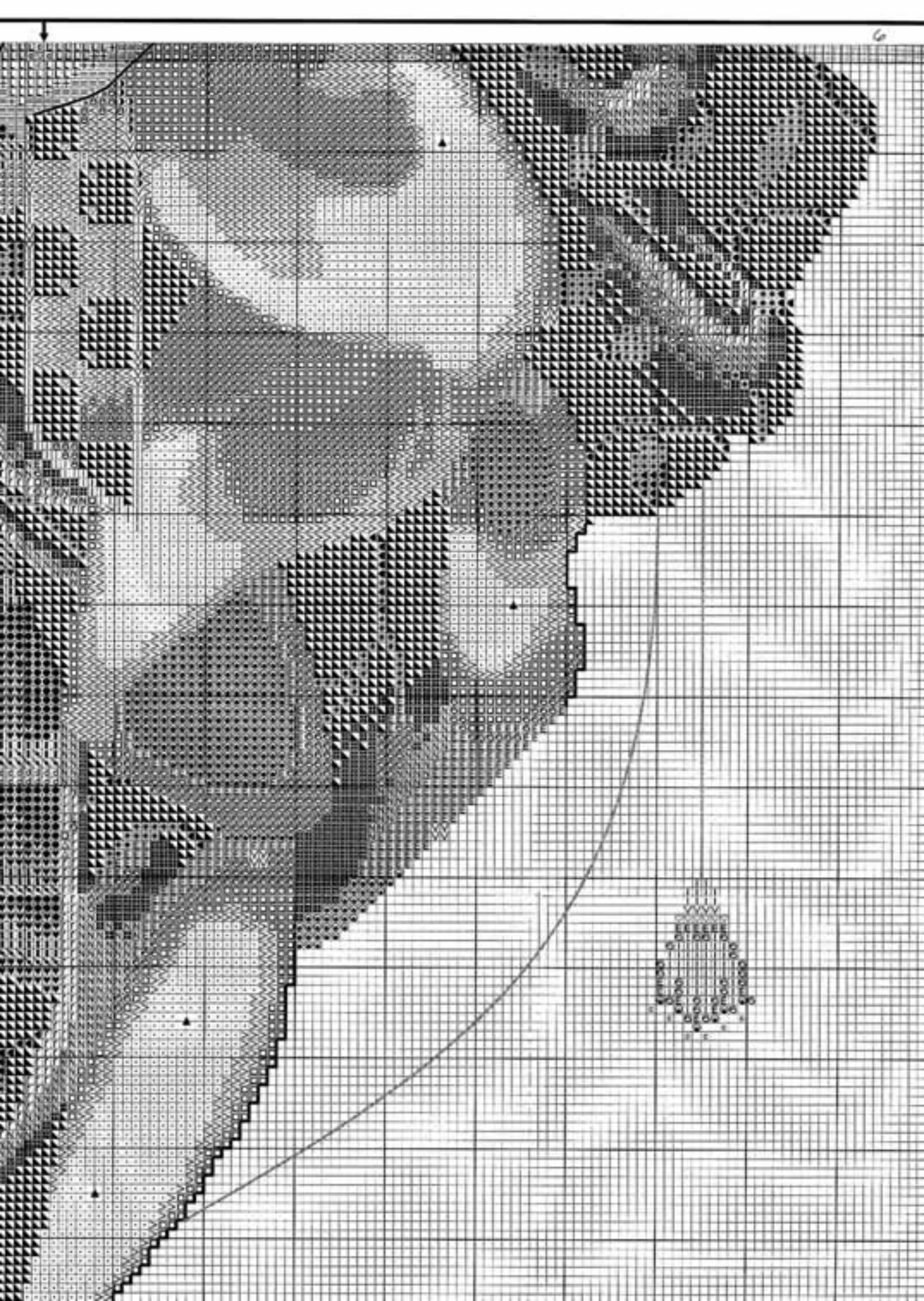
Create the bead roping using one strand of white floss. The bead sequence is shown below.

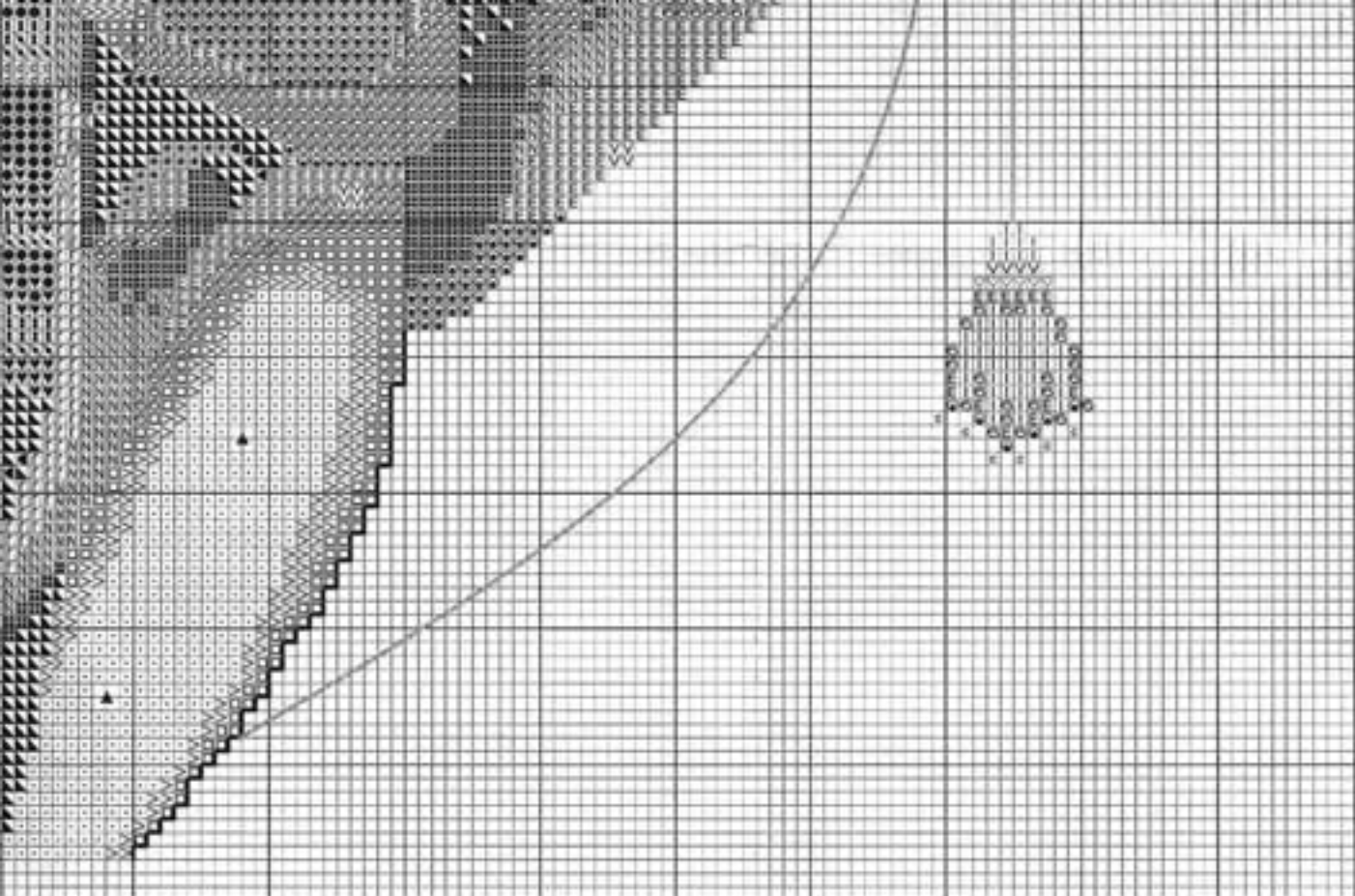
